More Campout details

Fishing

If you would like to fish, a **Washington Fishing License** is required. Bring your own gear and tackle for bank fishing for trout in Trout Lake Creek. Also bring nets if you want to hunt for crawdads.

Innertubing — If you want to float down Trout Lake Creek, bring life jackets, water floaties and innertubes if you have them. Tubes will be available to rent for \$5 per tube for the whole weekend.

Caving — You will need a helmet and flashlight.

Trout Lake Days

As part of "Trout Lake Days," The Trout Lake Fire Department offers a breakfast on Saturday (Adults \$7; 12 and under \$5) at Trout Lake School.

Items to Remember

Suggested items to remember (other than your own personal camping gear): Rain jacket and warm clothes,

life jackets if tubing, water floaties, innertubes (for floating down Trout Lake Creek), helmet and flashlight (if caving), camp stoves, roasting sticks, chairs, lanterns, flashlights, portable tables, bug spray, fishing gear, fishing licenses, board or card games, tarps or pop-up canopy covers (in case of rain).

Grills & Tables — We need people to bring grills and/or tables. Please call Tonya (541-490-3278) if you can help with these items.

Dogs

Well-behaved dogs only, please. Dogs need to be ON LEASH at all times. If you have any questions, please check with Tonya before planning to bring your dog.
