CAMA is the relief arm of the Christian and Missionary Alliance. CAMA provides a variety of relief and development ministries that flesh out the good news of God’s love for people, body and soul.

Andy was appointed by the C&MA to begin a refugee program. Over the years as CAMA expanded, they worked in Beirut, Jordan, Iraq, Indonesia, Ethiopia, Kenya and a variety of African countries. In Russia he was Executive Director for 5 years with the CoMission, while Bev began a continuing education program for nurses. Their final assignment was in the Balkans. After living in nine countries, they now reside in Lynden Washington.

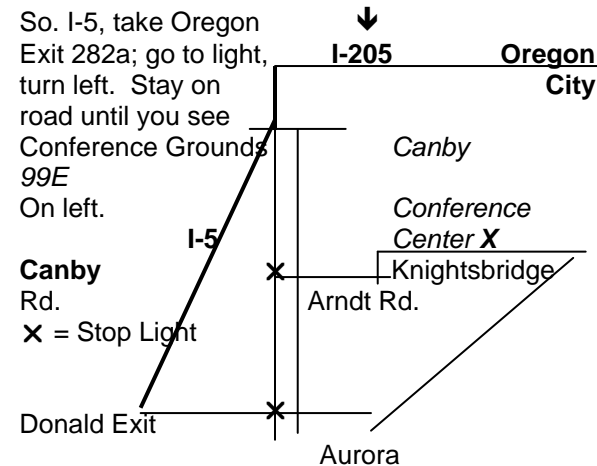
Service Project
